

## NOTES

Note 1: Cell F17 indicates the minimum number of total instructional areas to be provided. Value shall be rounded up.

Note 2: Values shown in cells F20-22 indicated the range of square foot per student based on the number of total students. Schools with larger enrollments will have fewer square feet per student.

Note 3: Cell D23 indicates the total gross square footage of the new or renovated building
Note 4: The minimum number of instructional areas within the Academic Core area for Elementary Schools will be $100 \%$ of total. The minimum number of instructional areas Middle \& High school Acadernic Core areas should be >=67\% of total.

Note 5: Cell D46 indicates the difference between the Maximum Reimbursable Gross Square Footage and the Total Gross 5quare Feet Programmed. A negative number indicates additional
5 F can be added to the program. A positive number is SF that is not state funded.
